REMEMBER GUN SAFETY

Dear Field Test Participants,

The Midnight Sun Gun Dog Association (MSGDA) will be hosting a Licensed HRC Hunt Test on Saturday July 31 and Sunday August 1 at Falcon Ridge upland game bird farm. There will be double events during the weekend with a Started, Seasoned, and Finished test on both Saturday and Sunday. Qualifying dogs and their owners will be awarded an official HRC/UKC rosette and accompanying band. There will be a potluck barbecue following the events on Saturday.

DIRECTIONS TO HUNT TEST FROM EAGLE RIVER/ANCHORAGE

Take the Glen Highway North to the Parks Highway and turn left. Go past Wasilla Lake and turn left (south) on Knik Goose Bay Road. Drive 17 miles and turn right on Point MacKenzie Road. Drive 7 miles to where the pavement ends. Turn right on gravel road. Go 0.1 of a mile and turn left on Ayrshire Road. Travel approximately 1 mile, turn right towards Carpenter Lake and follow the signs to Falcon Ridge Upland Game Farm.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

BIRDS: Live and/or dead ducks may be used for all tests. The day of the event should not be the first time you introduce your dog to these birds. Your dog will not pass the field test if it fails to pick up a bird. Many club members have training birds for sale; please contact one of them for price and availability.

FIELD TEST COURTESY: Do not drive on fields. Please 5 mph around the fields to avoid stirring up dust and limit the creation of mud; remember we are given the opportunity to use the property by the land owners and we don't want to limit our use of their fields in the future! Do not go through any gates unless instructed to do so. Come prepared to "scoop the poop" and pick up any trash. Thank you in advance for your consideration of others.

FIELD TEST HEADQUARTERS: Falcon Ridge Upland Game Farm.

FOOD AND WATER: Tests normally last most of the day. Please bring food and plenty of water for you and your dogs.

SATURDAY POTLUCK BARBECUE: MSGDA will host a barbecue following the events on Saturday. This is a potluck barbecue. We are asking all MSGDA club members to bring a side dish (i.e. appetizer, salad, fruit or dessert). This is a family event, so we encourage you to bring your entire family.

RECYCLING: During our events we will have two recycling bins; one for plastic bottles and a second for aluminum.
